### From the Principal

Ivanhoe Grammar School is once again proud of the achievements of our Year 12 students. The standard of academic achievement was once again high from our students who chose to study either the VCE or International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma.

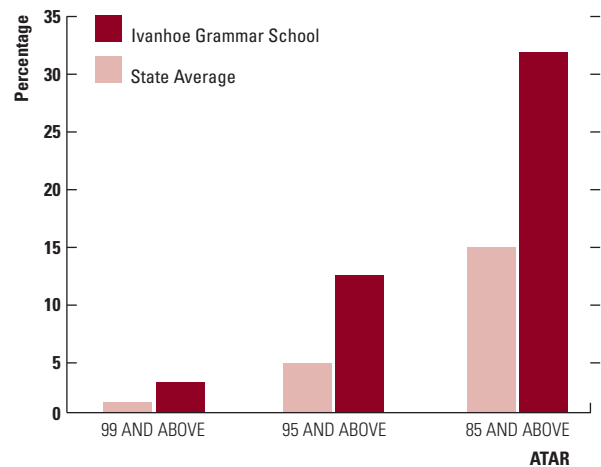
Overall, 13% of students achieved an ATAR of 95 or above which places them in the top 5% of the state and 20% of students achieved an ATAR of 90 or above placing them in the top 10% of the State. There were also 20 perfect subject scores achieved and by far the majority of students received their first choice of first round tertiary offers.

The School's open entry policy provides for a wonderfully diverse community where students of all abilities are given an opportunity to experience an Ivanhoe education, what we call **The Ivanhoe Factor**.

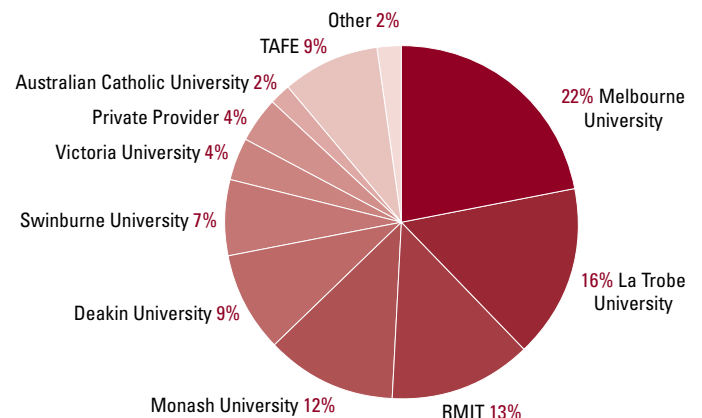
### 2010 VCE and IB Results
