## NOTEBOOK PROGRAM FOR YEARS 5-6

Dear Parents

As your child enters Year 5 at Ivanhoe Grammar School it is a requirement for all students to have a personal notebook computer to complement their studies at school and at home. Prior to 2011 Parents purchased a notebook themselves, either through the School's Notebook Program or via external sources.

In 2012, as in 2011, the School will provide all students entering Year 5 with an Acer Aspire 1830T Notebook. The cost of the netbook will be included in the Composite Fee and will cover:

- Acer Aspire 1830T Notebook;
  - Intel® Core i3 380UMB 1.33Ghz processor
  - 4GB RAM
  - 320GB Hard Drive
  - 11.6 inch LED HD screen
  - 6 Cell Battery, giving 6+ hours
- AC Adapter;
- Hard Case;
- 3 Years Manufacturer's Warranty;
- 2 Years Damage Cover;
- Software and Support.

### **Year 5 Notebooks 2012 – Terms**

In 2012 Ivanhoe Grammar School will provide all students entering Year 5 with a notebook computer for their studies at School and home. The computer will be an Acer Aspire 1830T Notebook supplied with a case, adapter, warranty and damage repair.

#### **Payment**

The total cost of the notebook will be included in the Composite Fee, spread over the course of Year 5 and 6.

At the end of the 2 years the notebook will belong to the student providing that all Composite Fee payments have been made.

Should the student leave early and not complete Year 6 then the notebook must be returned to the School.

The Program is compulsory in Years 5 and 6.

#### **Support**

In the event of software issues or failure the School will provide free software support to students. This may involve re-installing software, running diagnostic or anti-virus software or re-imaging the notebook to return it to full working order.

#### **Warranty, Damage and Repair**

Each notebook will be covered by a 3 year manufacturer's warranty against faulty parts. A School operated program will cover the notebook for repair or replacement due to theft, loss or damage. In the event of theft, loss or damage parents will be required to contribute towards the cost of replacement or repair:

- 1<sup>st</sup> claim - \$100 or value of repair if less
- 2<sup>nd</sup> claim - \$150 or value of repair if less
- 3<sup>rd</sup> claim - \$200 or value of repair if less

In the event of theft, loss or damage all claims must be accompanied with a completed claim form. In the event of a theft or loss please supply a Police Report. The School will not cover any repair or replacement of parts caused by wilful damage as determined by IT Services in its discretion, in which case the Parents will be required to fund the total repair cost.

Theft, loss or damage must be reported immediately to IT Services.

All repairs will be carried out by a certified Acer repair centre.

The School will purchase additional notebooks to ensure that, should a repair be required, the student is not without a notebook for more than 24 hours.
